**Series Hi-Point Buckle Award:** 13 & Under, 14 - 18, 19 & Over. Overall Hi-Point to participate at all 3 shows with same horse/rider combination. In case of a tie, showmanship placing will break it.

**Judge's decision is final.** Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes and excuse horse and/or rider for inappropriate behavior. Refunds will be given if excused from class by the judge.

**Novice Rider** not to have won three blue ribbons in their respective discipline.

**Attire:** Boots required, show clothes are optional, protective headgear is encouraged passing current applicable ASTM standards.

**Ribbons** and awards will have a designated table and time for awards to be picked up and will be announced daily and posted on the outside of the inside office. We will not be accepting returned ribbons at the end of the show.

**If you need to add or scratch a class, there will be forms outside the Inside Horse Show Office to fill out.**

1. If you need to add a class, it must be done at least 3 classes prior to the class start
2. If you need to scratch a class, it must be done PRIOR to the start of the class.
3. Payments of added classes and/or refunds for scratched classes will be processed at the indoor Horse Show Office at the end of each show day.

**No exhibitor gatherings with food/banquet style and food may not be left on tables in the aisleways in the barn areas.**

## **Winter Woolies Spring Fling Health Protocols to be followed:**

### **New Updates as of 8/10/2020 – Proclamation 20-25 Agriculture Events**

Face Mask or Face Shield is MANDATORY! Please keep a face mask or face shield on your face and with you at all times. Due to the recent mandates put in place by the Governor, face masks/shields are required at all times. **EXCEPTION: When mounted and/or showing/handling while being judged.**

Due to the most recent Governor restriction, no group larger than 5 may stand together, the distance between those groups of 5 or less must be 15 feet apart. In order to have this show, we have agreed to the Governor's office that everyone will follow this mandate.

### **Due to Covid-19 issues everyone needs to stay within their own group.**

Volunteers will be asking for small gatherings to maintain social distancing.

Every exhibitor must sign a liability release and waiver before being allowed to pick up their back number.

Anyone attending the show must be listed on the waiver form.

Exhibitors are required to pre-enter and complete all paperwork, which must be mailed and post marked by the dates listed on the show form.

All stall and RV reservations must be paid for prior to the event. If you end up cancelling your participation, refunds will be allowed.

Face masks will be available if needed. Hand sanitizers will be placed all over the CCF facilities

### **Outside daily spectators and vendors are NOT allowed to attend.**

**There shall be no other people on the fair grounds other than exhibitors, show staff, and professionals required to provide immediate and necessary care of a horse, i.e. veterinarians and farriers, with the exception of exhibitors who are minors, who are allowed to be accompanied by ONE adult (adults with minors must be named on page 2).**

We are asking that you all be respectful to all show staff and volunteers during this change in how we are having a horse show.

The indoor show office will be limited to one person per staffed window. We will have a 6-foot social distancing marker for exhibitors to wait for their turn.

*The show COVID-19 supervisor is Alice Heller; there will be Protocol liaisons working the show to ensure protocols are followed.*

Only show staff and announcer will be allowed in the show office area.

Exhibitors are asked to sign up for every class you might think you want to enter. This will help with all the daily questions asking how many are in each class. There will be form outside the Inside Horse Show Office where you can add or scratch a class. If you need to add a class, it must be done at least 3 classes prior; payment will be due via check at the end of the show. If you need to scratch a class, it must be done PRIOR to the start of the class. Payments of added classes and/or Refunds for scratched classes will be processed at the indoor Horse Show Office at the end of each show day.

The form of payment for this show will be check or money order made out to the CCEHC.

Show manager will have a staff meeting at the end of each show day to discuss issues, protocol and procedures that will be in place during the event.

If needed, we will allow 3-minute gate holds to allow exhibitors to move in and around the closed areas near the arena and warm up area. Please contact the in-gate person

Bathrooms and high traffic areas will be closed several times a day for additional cleaning.

Riders and people on foot must keep 6 feet of space between each other at all times; this includes no gatherings or set up of chairs along the arena wall.

Arena entrances/exits will be arranged so that riders are not coming in close contact entering/exiting the arenas. Riders are to follow direction for entering /exiting. We are only allowed 50 people to be in the arena at one time. That includes those in the viewing area and exhibitors. If we go over the 50 persons allowed in the arena, we will ask those in the viewing area to leave first. The judge, announcer, ring steward and show staff is not included in the 50 person limitation. Only the next 2 classes will be allowed in the covered warm up arena; if, however, the number of riders in the show arena plus the number of riders in the the warm-up arena total more than 50, then riders in the warm up arena will be asked to leave.

Once exhibitors enter the warm up arena, face masks are not required if you are handling or riding a horse/mini/pony. All others are required to wear a mask or face shield. Wash racks will be closed to bathing of horses.

By signing this waiver you are agreeing to all the Social Distancing and Washington State CDC Covid-19 Compliant practices that have been put into place for the show and will be adhered to, including wearing a mask or face shield **at all times** while on the Clark County Fairgrounds property. The only exception is when you are mounted on a horse or showing/handling a horse. Group gatherings larger than 5 in the barn areas and in/around the show arena and CCF property are not permitted; groups of 5 must be a minimum of 15 feet apart and all must wear a face mask or shield - NO EXCEPTIONS! You will be asked to leave with no refunds if you cannot comply with this mandate. No outside spectators will be allowed.
